

Captain James Cook is believed to have rowed up Cooks River to Tempe in May 1770. The River has its source at Chullora, 23 km upstream from Botany Bay. This event will cover the lower Cooks River region, discovering Wolli Creek, Cup & Saucer Creek and the Alexandra Canal/Sheas Creek tributaries. The remnant vegetation of the Cooks River valley, the wetlands and features of historical interest are some of the highlights of the course.

When: Sunday 23rd February with a 9am start and 3pm finish.

Map: 1:25,000 new-edition, standard topographic map with 10-metre contours; pre-marked with checkpoints.

Terrain: Diverse scenery, from riverside parks, through suburban residential and heavy industrial precincts, including remnant Cooks River woodland and wetlands.

Who can enter: For insurance reasons, you must be a member of a rogaining association. If you are not currently a member please include the membership fee with your entry (individual = \$17, Family =\$17+ \$5 every other person in the family).

Teams and categories: A team consists of between 2 and 5 people. Team categories are for Men, Women or Mixed gender, within Junior (all team members 14-17), Veteran (all \geq 40) or Superveteran (all \geq 55) age groups. A Family team contains at least one person \leq 17 and their grand/parent. Any team with a child under 14 must also have an adult in the team.

Entry fees: \$25 adults; \$15 student, unemployed or pensioner; \$50 maximum fee for a family. Entry fee covers the cost of the map and a light meal after the event.

Entries close Friday 14th February 2003.

Entries postmarked after that date will incur a late fee.

Transport to the event: Public transport will be easily available. More details will be with the final event info.

Detailed event information: Will be mailed to all team contacts about one week prior to the event. It will identify the exact location of the event, transport options, an equipment checklist, and any special preparations.
