



THE TURON GOLD RUSH

8/24 HR ROGAINE
28-29 APRIL 2007



The Event: The NSWRA Autumn Rogaine will be held on the banks and tributaries of the Turon River in the Central Tablelands of NSW.

Location: The upper reaches of the Turon River are located west of Capertee. It is a 3 hour drive west from Sydney via Lithgow. The shortest route from the ACT is via Bathurst.

Terrain and map: The fast terrain ranges from pleasant shady river banks to open forested hills highlighted by distinct features. About 2/3 rds of the course is dry eucalypt forest with the remainder being cleared farmland. The map is a 1:25 000 topographic map with 10 m contours. Ruins from the Gold rushes 150 years ago can be found over most of the course.

Hash House: The Hash House site is at "Turon Gates". There is a large space available for camping amongst casuarinas on river flats. Limited hot showers will be available. Camping for Friday and Saturday nights is included in the entry fee.

For those who want some extra comfort, there are cabins available for rent close to the Hash House (<http://www.turongates.com>). To book a cabin phone (02) 99693818. Cabin bookings should be made well in advance.

Teams and categories: Teams may consist of 2-5 people. Team categories are Men, Women, Mixed, Junior (14-17), Veteran (40+), Superveteran (55+), Novice (first Rogaine for all team members), and Family (team members must all belong to the same family with at least one parent or grandparent and one child under 18). Any team with a child under 14 must also have an adult member.

Who can enter? Anyone of any age can enter this event. All entrants 18 years or over must be a member of a state rogaining association. In NSW, fees cover the cost of insurance and ARA affiliation fees. You can join the NSW Rogaining Association and include the membership fee with your entry to this event.

Entry fees:

- **Adults:** \$70
- **Concession:** \$50
- **Family max:** \$140
- **Late fee:** \$10 per person after 12 April.

Enter via the NSWRA website or the form overleaf.

Duration Options: There are two event durations, 8 hour and 24 hour. Both options will start at 12 noon on Saturday 28 April. The 8 hour event finishes at 8 pm on Saturday whilst the 24 hour event finishes at 12 noon on Sunday.
