

17th Annual Lake Macquarie Rogaine

11 October 2008

6 & 12 hour Events

The Lake Macquarie Rogaine will once again be held in the Watagan Mountains as part of the Lake Macquarie Games and supported by the Lake Macquarie City Council. The Watagan Mountain is west of Australia's largest coastal salt water lake and with the location for this year's event being in the area known as The Pines which is only two hours north of Sydney. The area to be used will mostly be in the Watagan National Park with beautiful rainforest, pristine creeks, friendly fauna and an extensive track network to allow competitors the option of avoiding some of the navigation through dense vegetation.

Map: 1:25000 pre marked maps

When: Both events will commence with a mass start at 12 midday Saturday 11 October

Hash House: The hash house will operate from 5pm Saturday until 1am Sunday. Camping is available at the area and competitors in the 12 hour event are encouraged to camp overnight to reduce the chances of fatigue induced car accidents on the way home. Breakfast will be provided on Sunday morning.

Who can Enter: Anyone can enter, although those under 14 must have an adult in their team. You do not have to be a member of the NSW Rogaining Association to enter

Teams: A team may consist of 2 to 5 people.

Team Categories: Men, Women and Mixed categories are available in Open, Junior (14 – 17 yrs) Veteran (40yrs +), Superveterans (55yrs +). A Novice category (first rogaine for all team members) and Family category (team members must all belong to the one family and have at least one parent or grandparent and one child under 18yrs of age on the first day of competition.. Any team with a child under 14yrs must also have an adult in the team.

Entry Fee: \$57 adult, \$40 student, unemployed or pensioner, maximum for a family \$114. For fee purposes a family is defined as: One or two adults plus any number of dependant children each of whom looks to one or both of the adults as a parent and who all live at the same address.

- Entries postmarked after 26 September will incur a late penalty of \$10 per person.
