### Course-setter's notes

- There are many unmarked cliffs, usually in areas where the contours are close together.
- Creeks are harder walking than the spurs.
- Checkpoints 81, 101 and 90 should be attempted by experienced teams only
- Novice loops – (shorter) 20, 31, 40, 44, 33, 32, HH; (longer) 20, 31, 40, 45, 70, 48, T&D, 82, 32, HH.
