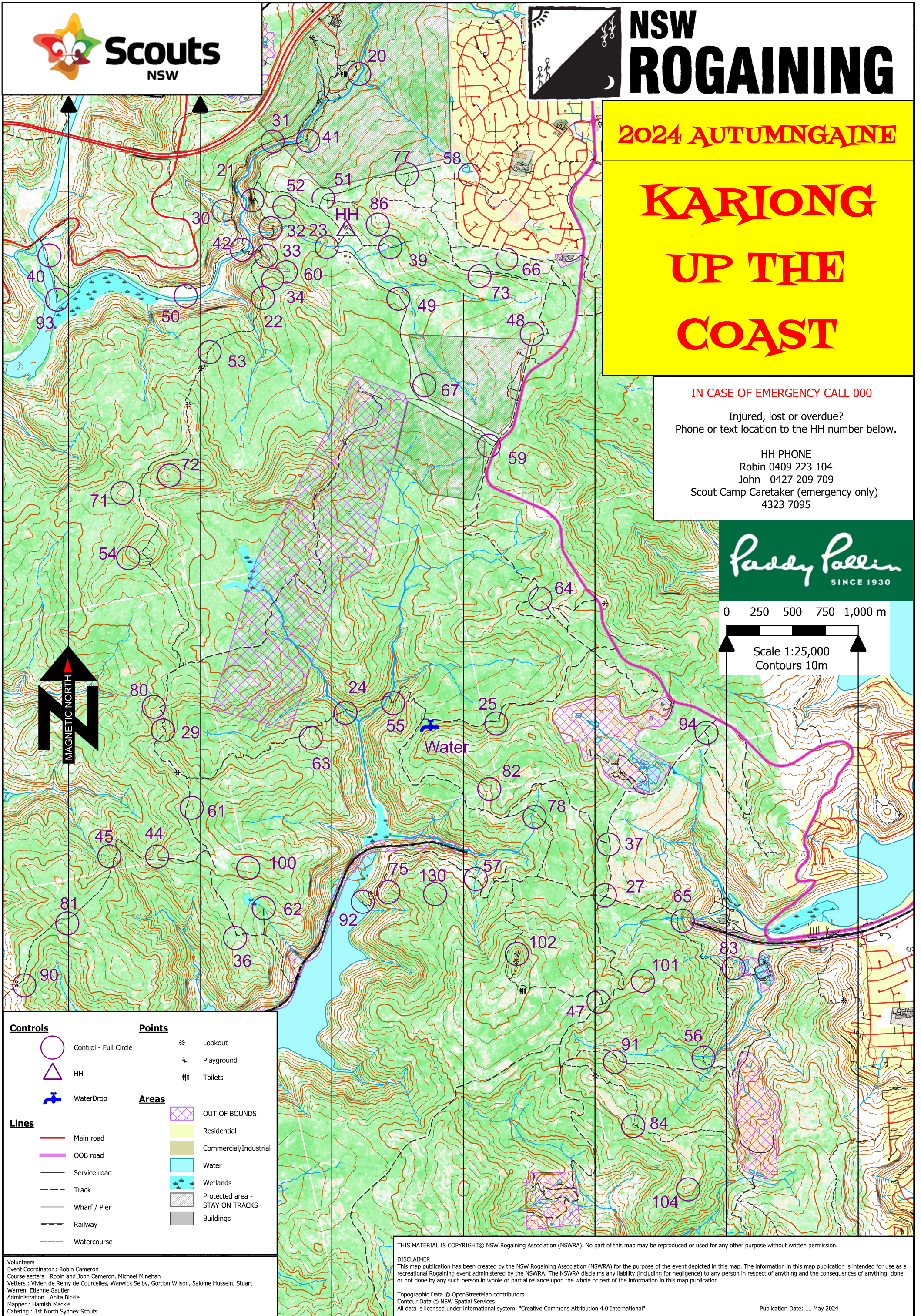

COURSE SETTERS NOTES:

- Do not enter any of the Out of Bounds (OOB) areas marked with pink hatching.
- Please stay away from the residents' areas in the Scout Camp. Pink hatching shows the OOB sections in the camp area. Move through the areas near there quietly at night.
- Protected areas are marked with grey shading on the map, stay on tracks in those areas except for Control 67 which is easily reached across relatively open ground.
- Woy Woy Road is Out Of Bounds
- There is absolutely no access along or across the train line corridor next to Mullet Creek ie between 62 and 92.
- The bush is very thick and scratchy in most areas and most of the off track controls are close to the tracks or accessible using fairly open rocky platforms.
- Pay attention to the map which shows the vegetation fairly accurately.
- The offtrack route from 75-130 is very slow going but with some open sections.
- Approach 71 from the track, SW of the control.
- The firetrail NW of the private property on Woy Woy Rd (Roy Lamb the Sandman) is not accessible from Woy Woy Rd. Please respect private property.
- There are unmarked tracks around Control 20 (which is on a small unmarked track)
- There are unmarked tracks around 65 but the route to 83 is taped.
- The route to 92 is taped from the top of the track.
- If you are late or injured please phone the Hash House number/s. - If it is an emergency phone 000 first then the HH number/s.

SUGGESTED NOVICE ROUTES:

- Hash south via 49, 67 to 59, then north via 48, 73, 66, 58, 77, 86, 51,52, 21 then Hash. This is about 9 km. There are multiple small points near the Hash which can be easily picked up at the end if time and energy permits.
- Another possible novice course is generally north from the Hash via 51, 52, 21, 32, 33, 42, (50), 30,31, 20, 41 and back to Hash. This is about 6+ km but there is plenty of scope to extend it by picking up the small points close to the Hash and/or eg going out and back to pick up 49 and 62 on the Scout Camp Fire Trail.
